

# Just Be Claus it's Christmas

MAYWOOD  STUDIO



1. Sew the fabric 2 (Border 1) strips to the fabric 1 20½" x 20½" square, mitering the corners. Press the seam allowances toward Border 1. (See Tips section at [www.maywoodstudio.com](http://www.maywoodstudio.com) for Mitered Border instructions.)
2. Sew the shorter Border 2 strips to the sides of the quilt. Press away from quilt center. Sew the long Border 2 strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press away from quilt center.
3. Repeat the Border 2 process for Border 3.



4. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste to secure layers. Quilt as desired.
5. Bind using a ¼" seam allowance.



## SPECIAL CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Cut the four scene center of the Just Be Claus panel 20½" x 20½". The remainder of the panel can be used for fabric Christmas ornaments, or for keepsake gift tags.

Cut four 4½" x 36" border cuts from the stripe. Leave approximately 3/8" of the cream background away from the red stripe.

	<p>Fabric 4 MAS8622-G ½ yd</p>	<p>From Fabric 4, cut: 4 — 3½" x WOF strips, into: 2 — 30½" lengths 2 — 36½" lengths for Border 3</p>
	<p>Fabric 5 MAS8626-R 1/3 yd</p>	<p>From Fabric 5, cut: 4 — 2¼" x WOF strips for Binding</p>
