Santa's Choice Table Runner

Finishes 12" x 44"



Cutting

Cut 5 ornament of your choice from the Just Be Claus panel sections 4-1/2" square

Cut 4 squares Natural Tiny Tree Fabric 4-1/2" square

Cut 20 Rectangles Natural Tiny Tree Fabric 2-1/2" x 4-1/2"

Cut 4 squares Natural Tiny Tree Fabric 2-1/2" square

Cut 40 Red Snowflakes Fabric 2-1/2" squares.

Borders

First Inner Border— Itty Bitty Green Dots: Cut 2 Sides—8-1/2" x 1", and Cut 2 (Top and Bottom) 1" x 41-12"

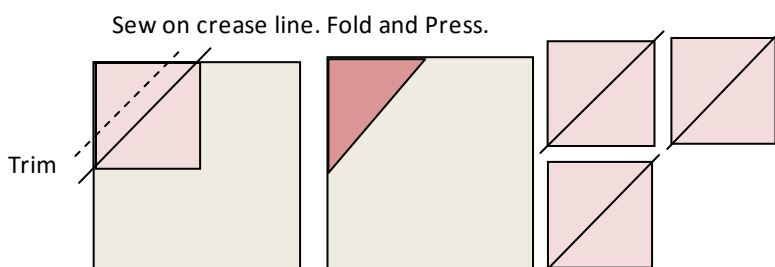
Outer Border (Red Tiny Trees) Cut 2 sides—2" x 9-1/2" and Cut 2 (Top and Bottom 2" x 44-1/2"

Backing—JBC Words Green

Binding—1/2 " Finished Binding was used. Cut 3 Strips 2-1/2"

Make 4 Square in a Square Blocks

Using 16 of the 2-1/2" Red squares, finger press squares creating a diagonal crease on the square. Place Wrong Sides Together, corner to corner on the 4-1/2" White Tree square. Sew together using the diagonal line as a guide and press to corner. Trim excess from seam to reduce bulk. Do this to all 4 corners. Make 4.



Make 12 Flying Geese Blocks

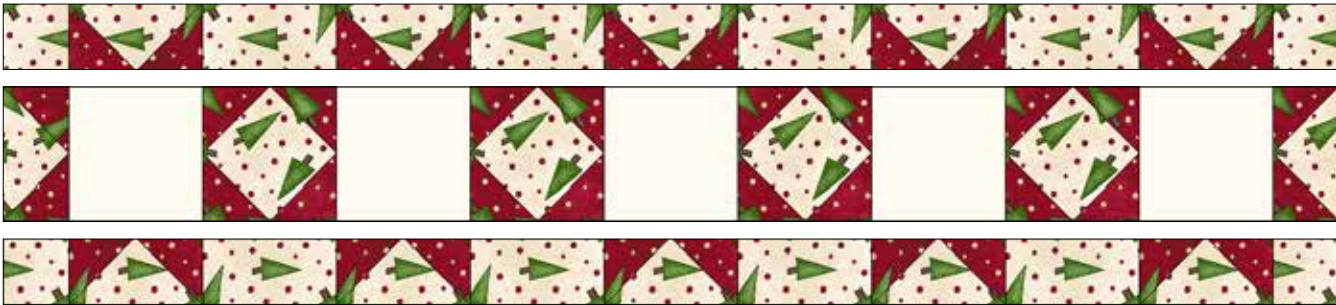


This is the same technique as Square in a Square. Using the remaining 24 - 2-1/2" Red Snowflakes squares, finger press squares creating a diagonal crease on the square. Place Wrong Sides Together, corner to corner using 12 of the 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Tiny Tree fabrics. Sew on the diagonal line and press. Trim excess from seam to reduce bulk. Do this to both corners. Make 12.

Finishing

Layout Table runner as shown using Flying Geese sections, Square in a Square, Tiny Tree Fabric remaining rectangles and squares. Using 1/4" seam allowance, sew sections as shown. Then sew rows matching intersections.

*White squares represent ornaments.










Sew inner border sides, then top and bottom.

Sew outer border sides, then top and bottom.



Layer table runner top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired.

Use your favorite Binding technique. Ours finishes 1/2" using the green JBC Words fabric.

	<p>MAS8625-G Green Dots 1/8 yd</p>	<p>For inner border, Cut 2 1" x 8 1/2" strips</p> <p>Cut 2 1" x 41 1/2" strips</p>
	<p>MAS8623-R Red with Tiny Trees 1/4 yd</p>	<p>For outer border, Cut 2 2" x 9 1/2" strips</p> <p>Cut 2 2" x 44 1/2" strips</p>
