MAYWOOD  STUDIO

1. Trim the panel to 28½" x 41½".

Add Border 1

2. Sew the 2½" x 41½" strips of Fabric 1 to the sides of the panel.

3. Sew the 2½" x 32½" strips of Fabric 1 to the top and bottom of the panel.



Piece & Add Border 2

4. Using Fabric 1 sashing strips, Fabric 2 rectangles and Fabric 3 squares, assemble two strips as shown.



5. Sew to the top and bottom of the panel.

6. Using Fabric 1 sashing strips, Fabric 2 squares & rectangles, and Fabric 3 squares & rectangles, assemble two strips as shown.



7. Sew to the sides of the quilt.

Add Border 3

8. Sew the Border 3 strips of Fabric 1 together end to end. Measure horizontally through the middle of the quilt. Trim two borders to this length. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the borders.

9. Measure and trim two Border 3 strips the length of the quilt. Sew to the sides of the quilt, pressing toward the borders.

Add Border 4

10. Using the Border 4 strips of Fabric 5, repeat the same process in steps 8 and 9 to attach Border 4 to the quilt.









Finishing the Quilt

11. Layer the backing wrong side up, the batting and the quilt top right side up. Baste, then quilt as desired.

12. Prepare the binding by joining the Fabric 5 binding strips with diagonal seams pressed open. Fold the binding in half, wrong sides together and press to make a double binding.

13. Sew the binding to the quilt with a 3/8" seam allowance, mitering the corners. Trim the excess batting and backing, turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.

	<p>Fabric 2 MASF8331-Z ½ yd</p>	<p>From Fabric 2, cut: 2 — 6 ½" x 42" strips, into: 8 — 6 ½" squares 2 — 6 ½" x 12 ½" rectangles</p>
	<p>Fabric 3 MASF8332-A ½ yd</p>	<p>From Fabric 3, cut: 2 — 6 ½" x 42" strips, into: 8 — 6 ½" squares 2 — 6 ½" x 9 ½" rectangles</p>
	<p>Fabric 4 MASF8330-Z 1 panel</p>	<p>From Fabric 4, cut: 1 — 28 ½" x 41 ½" piece, centering motif</p>
	<p>Fabric 5 MASF8333-A 1¾ yds</p>	<p>From Fabric 5, cut: 8 — 4 ½" x 42" strips for Border 4 8 — 2 ½" x 42" strips for Binding</p>
	<p>Fabric 6 MASF8332-E 3½ yds</p>	<p>Backing</p>
